

Instruction Sheet No. 1: Terms and Conditions of Delivery of REMONDIS SAVA GmbH

Solid waste that does not require crushing – Dry bulk –

In addition: Appendix to the Instruction Sheets No. 1, 2, 3 and 5: Materials that are not suitable for the bunker, shredder or paste (Exclusion List)

In advance of each delivery a detailed waste description in English or German language has to be provided (current analysis, safety data sheet). Likewise, a representative sample of the waste may be submitted. **Please contact us in case of deviations from the conditions specified herein!**

Consistency of the waste: solid

Possible delivery systems:

- _ Lift-off or roll-off containers (with foil)
- _ Tipping semi-trailer (with foil)

Delivery conditions (please contact us in case of deviations):

- _ Flashpoint > surrounding temperature (applies always)
- _ Mercury < 3 ppm (or mg/kg)
- _ Sulphur < 1.0 %
- _ Zinc < 1.0 %
- _ Organically bound silicon < 0.5 %
- _ Phosphorus < 1.0 %
- _ Fluorine < 0.1 %
- _ Solid to set consistency, no freely draining liquids within the waste
- _ Waste that requires crushing (Instruction Sheet No. 2) has to be strictly separated from waste that does not require crushing (Instruction Sheet No. 1)
- _ Max. edge length: 25 cm (no endless filter cloth, long tubing, long plastic foil, etc.)
- _ No solid metal parts (metal discs, iron pipes and rods, gears and castings, tubing with flange connectors, steel reinforcement, etc.)
- _ No stones or concrete lumps
- _ No intact, closed metal containers, no spray cans

Concerning **premixed waste**, the following additional specifications have to be complied:

- _ Flashpoint > 21 °C
- _ The preparing facility should at least have the following authorised facilities: shredder, mixer, laboratory

Excluded from the acceptance in the bunker are substances that are not suitable for the bunker due to their risk potential. For this the **Appendix to the Instruction Sheets No. 1, 2, 3 and 5: Materials that are not suitable for the bunker, shredder or paste (Exclusion List)** has to be observed. Those are, for example, dusty, reactive, smelling, toxic substances. These substances – appropriately packed – can be accepted for the drum lift (see Instruction Sheet No. 4).

Completely excluded from the acceptance and not permitted are gaseous, explosive and radioactive substances, likewise chemical and biological warfare agents, genetically modified materials, as well as asbestos and carbon fibre reinforced plastics.
